

DOLPHIN DEMOCRATS GENERAL MEETING

President Noah Kitty asked the Judicial candidates to recess to the Entrance Hall so the Dolphin members could complete a brief business meeting.

Meeting called to order at 7:35pm by President Noah Kitty.

Secretary Edward Leuchs acknowledged that there was a quorum present.

Following the Pledge of Allegiance, President Noah Kitty called for a moment of silence in memory of Marcia Beach , former Broward County Commissioner and Broward County Drug Court Judge . Fort Lauderdale Commissioner Dean Trantalis made additional comments regarding Max Schubert who was founder of the Pride Center.

Approval of General Meeting Minutes

Secretary Ed Leuchs explained that an objection raised regarding previously approved February 10 minutes had led to changes to the review process for the February 10, March 9, April 13 and May 11, 2016 General Meeting minutes. Each set of General Meeting minutes was reviewed at a June 2 meeting of the Executive Committee. Corrected minutes had been posted on the Dolphin website and paper copies were available for review. Karla Vogt made a motion, seconded by Naomi Siegel, to approve the minutes of the February 10, March 9, April 13 and May 11, 2016 General Meetings as posted. The motion was approved by majority vote. There were two “no” votes.

Treasurer's Report

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Treasurer Stewart Pepper who reported a balance of \$8,163 in the Dolphins' bank account. The Treasurer's Report was accepted through a motion by Michael Albetta, which was seconded by Patti Lynn and passed by unanimous vote.

Volunteers for Stonewall Pride, Pride Center Saturday Flea Market and Voter Registration Training

President Noah Kitty invited all Dolphin members to attend the Stonewall Pride event in Wilton Manors on Saturday, June 18. She thanked Sheriff Scott Israel for sponsoring the Dolphin Democrats' booth and asked the members to assist in staffing the booth and marching in the parade.

Members were also invited to staff the Dolphin Democrats' booth at the Pride Center Flea Market which will take place the first Saturday of each month, starting Saturday, July 2 and ending Saturday, November 5, 2016.

President Noah Kitty encouraged Dolphin Democrats to attend the Florida LGBT Democratic Caucus Gala to be held at Bahia Mar on July 8, 9 and 10. It was explained that the Dolphin Democrats are hosting the event.

President Noah Kitty asked if there was any further New Business. There being none, the Business Meeting was adjourned at 7:52pm by motion of Ron Mills, seconded by Naomi Siegel.
