- 1. Welcome/Call to Order: President Alfredo Olvera Called the meeting to order at 7:03pm

- **6. New Business:** President Alfredo Olvera listed the LGBTQ+ elected officials in Broward and then introduced the panel members.
 - a. Guest Speakers:
 - i. Representative Omari Hardy could not attend.
 - b. A Conversation with LGBTQ+ Leaders
 - i. Florida Senator Shevrin Jones
 - Senator Jones spoke about the latest Florida legislative session and the Governor's deliberate actions towards the LGBTQ+ community in terms of the Trans Sports Ban as well as his current veto of funds that would LGBTQ+ community and Pulse nightclub survivors.
 - 2. He spoke about putting good candidates forward and engaging national organizations to get behind our candidates
 - 3. How can we ensure that the LGBTQ community gains full equality in Florida: He spoke about workforce protections for LGBTQ+ community as a way to move toward full equality
 - 4. Senator Jones announced that on August 7th at 10am, he is holding a bill writing workshop and a workshop on how to apply to state appropriations.
 - 5. He said that redistricting is the most important thing coming up in Florida.
 - ii. Hallandale Commissioner Sabrina Javellana
 - Commissioner Javellan explained that the State Legislature is making it harder and harder for cities to pass things because of preemptions by the State Legislature.
 - She discussed how Hallandale police didn't like her position on police violence and that she continues to fight for George Floyds and Breonna Taylor's of Hallandale.
 - She discussed full equality for the LGBTQ+ in terms of inclusion and said cities need to make sure that there are protections in every ordinance and resolution, and policies for the LGBTQ+ community
 - 4. She spoke about a letter to trans youth she and Commissioner Glassman and others worked on that told trans youth that they are supported, and which she asked community leaders to sign; she also said that Pride is a protest.
 - iii. Fort Lauderdale Commissioner Steve Glassman
 - Commissioner Glassman spoke about his time with the Dolphin Democrats.
 - He said the issues facing the Fort Lauderdale LGBTQ community are the same issues that the rest of America is facing. He discussed acknowledging and taking a stand on issues facing the LGBTQ community
 - He explained that the Commission cannot take an active role in policy and that the commission has no control over Fort Lauderdale schools, but he said the City has hired an education officer and has a strong Education Advisory Board.
 - 4. He said that it's important to make sure home rule is at the forefront.

- 5. He explained that Fort Lauderdale had a feeding program that just wrapped up; that Fort Lauderdale was the only city who took advantage of federal dollars; and that Fort Lauderdale has been proactive with Covid,
- 6. He spoke about having proclamations and recognizing good work; spoke about paid parenteral leave that would include LGBTQ parents.
- 7. He also discussed the letter that he and Commissioner Javellana worked on; he mentioned that some elected officials did not sign on. He recommended that constituents email their elected officials to let them know what is important to them
